Skills Development

- Design and conduct training to develop skills in accessing or using HIV/AIDS-related information and PrEP Navigator resources
 - Use of NLM HIV/AIDS web and/or mobile resources
 - Use of other tailored HIV/AIDS information resources in order to improve services and benefit the community
- *This may include the development of training courses for PrEP Navigators, HIV Navigators, clients and patrons, etc.*



Skills Development: Project Examples

- Capacity-building training and peer-to-peer education
- Information retrieval skills development training for health outreach workers and local community-based organizations
- Training, workshops, and webinars on *AIDSinfo*, *AIDSource*, and *MedlinePlus*
- Train-the-trainer courses on HIV/AIDS information resources

Skills Development: Measures

- The following measures will determine the impact of skills development
 - Number of trainings offered
 - Number of trained participants
 - Training satisfaction
 - Did the training course meet the needs of the intended audience?
 - Training outcomes
 - Increased knowledge
 - Increased skills (demonstrate online search techniques to access HIV/AIDS information)
